

SE 8TH STREET NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC PROJECT



CONSTRUCTION AHEAD

To address cut-through traffic on SE 8th and SE 6th Streets, the City and area residents developed a Neighborhood Traffic Plan. This plan was shared with the community in January and residents were asked whether or not they supported new signing and pavement markings on SE 6th St, two elongated speed humps and a double-chicane on SE 8th St. Of the survey's respondents, 86% supported the proposed plan.

Construction will occur within the next 4-6 weeks. This work will be done by the City Street Maintenance crews. The work will be spread out over the timespan of a week or so. For example, the installation of all new signs may occur during a Saturday and the construction of the speed humps would happen a few days later.


Chicane - Design Change and Interim Installation

During the ballot process, the design of the chicane was adjusted to address adjacent property concerns. A temporary chicane will be installed with paint and 18-inch high white delineators to be evaluated for effectiveness at the end of summer. If the chicane becomes permanent, it will be constructed with concrete curb and landscaping.



Additional Street Lighting

The construction of new physical measures requires additional lighting so drivers are aware of the new physical measures. Two new streetlights and poles will be installed and 2 other new streetlights on existing poles within the vicinity of the new devices. This work is being coordinated with Puget Sound Energy and will likely occur within the next 3-6 months.
